# LAKE ROTOITI COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLANNING

Recent weather events around the country are making us increasingly aware of the devastation natural disasters can cause in our local communities including loss of homes, infrastructure and sadly of lives. Rotorua Lakes Council is working with an initial response team, led by the Lake Rotoiti Community Association (LRCA), to create an Emergency Response plan should a disaster isolate the Rotoiti community for a period of three to seven days before help arrives.

The initial response team is tasked with defining our Rotoiti community, the facilities that exist within it, promoting preparedness, and engaging with the wider community. The most successful plan for the community will be the one that has been created by the community and the planning team is asking you to support this initiative. Due to the challenging geographical spread of east and west Rotoiti and a high proportion of non-permanent residents and visitors to the area, the team needs local support in order to create a thorough and robust plan.

#### **CAN YOU HELP?**

Are you already a key contact in your area or are you involved in a local group or organisation? Do you have contact details for others in your local community and are you able to reach out to them in an emergency? Communication will be an extremely important aspect of our plan, especially if 'normal' methods of communication are compromised and to reach the widest number of residents possible.

# DO YOU HAVE ACCESS TO RESOURCES THAT COULD BE CRITICAL IN AN EMERGENCY SITUATION?

If so, we need to hear from you! Be involved in shaping a plan which will not only help the community as a whole, but may be vital for the safety of your own whānau, friends and visitors.
