Kia ora koutou,

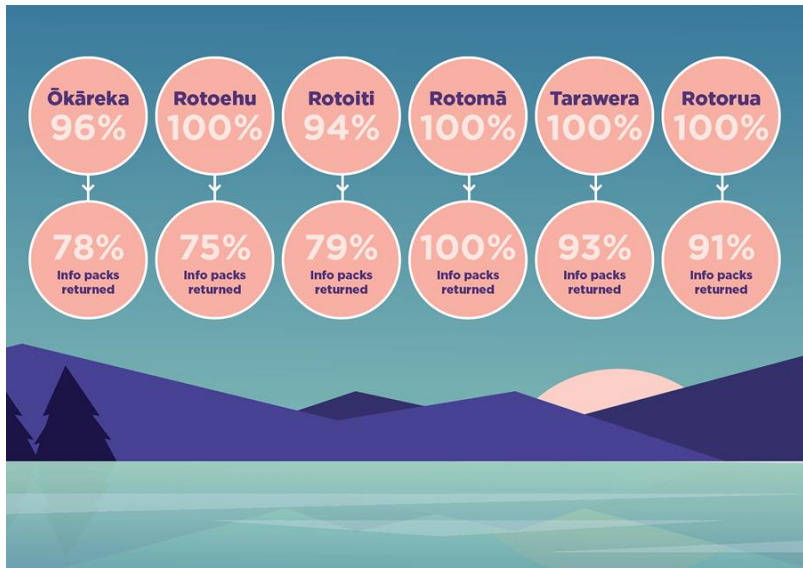

This is partly because a number of our staff are assisting Bay of Plenty Emergency Management to support the local Ministry of Health led response to COVID-19. Many of the agencies we work with, and who are involved in the lake structure replacement consent project, are also supporting the response.

For our Consents Team, we continue to process consent applications. This includes applications that are part of the lake structure replacement consent project. Because however this is a multi-agency project, it's likely there will be delays. This means that applications for existing structures are on hold and therefore applicants can continue to operate under their existing consent.
