ONSITE SYSTEM CONSENT FORM

Work on the East Rotoiti portion of our Sewerage Scheme is about to start, even as the Rotoma section is completed and the treatment plant commissioned. This will see the pipeline network through to Curtis Rd and including side roads being laid, and once that is completed the on-site units will start being installed and connected. Before that can happen Council needs permissions from each property owner.

Thank you to everyone who has signed and returned the forms Council sent out at the start of the year seeking permission to install the on-site portion of the Sewerage Scheme, and also giving Heritage NZ (is that the right name?) authority to investigate any archaeological finds.

The form doesn't determine where the on-site system will be installed on your property; you'll be contacted once we're closer to installing the units to decide on a location.
