Request made under the Official Information Act 1982

Thank you for your email of 14 March 2022 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

We request copies of all submissions relating to the sections of SH30 between 353m east of SH30/SH33 Tikitere Junction to 530m west of Matahi Road, made for the public consultation/survey 21 January to 18 February 2022, conducted by Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency

Changing speed limits is a legal process and all speed reviews undertaken by Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency are developed and delivered in line with the Speed Management Guide and the Setting of Speed Limits Rule 2017.

Before a final decision on the speed review can be made, there are numerous steps we need to follow, including an analysis of the consultation submissions alongside our technical review. Once completed, we will publish the consultation document on our website. This will include a summary of the consultation, how we reached our decision, and a table of the submissions we received. We are endeavouring to complete this step in the coming weeks. Therefore, as the information will soon be publicly available, I am refusing your request under section 18(d) of the Act.

We will provide you with an update on or before 5 May 2022 regarding where we are in the process and, once it is available, will also provide you with a link to the consultation documentation.

Under section 28 of the Act, you have the right to ask the Ombudsman to review my decision to refuse this request. The contact details for the Ombudsman can be located at www.ombudsman.parliament.nz.
