Have your say on safer speeds

State Highway 30 Tikitere to Whakatāne speed review public consultation is open

There's been a high number of crashes on State Highway 30 (SH30) between Tikitere and Whakatāne. This road is used for everything from commuting to freight to tourism. Or simply people trying to get their children to school or out for a mountain bike ride. The best thing we can do to prevent people from dying or being seriously injured is to make speed limits safer. Safer speed limits are safer for all road users. As your speed increases you have less time to react. A small reduction in speed can make a big difference, especially when cyclists or pedestrians are involved. Even when speed doesn't cause the crash, it's what will most likely to determine whether anyone is killed, injured, or walks away unharmed from that crash. Before we make a decision, we want to hear from you.

The SH30 speed limit consultation period runs from 21 January to 18 February 2022.
